



Create the Connection

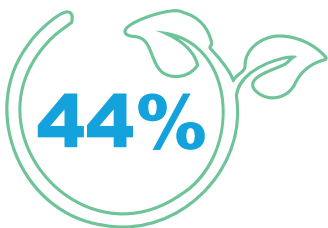
Tikvah empowers adults living with a mental illness so that they may feel accomplished, independent, and fulfilled. We strive to create and support member connections through social and educational programming.

Financial support by individuals and foundations allows Tikvah to continue to provide and grow these community connections.

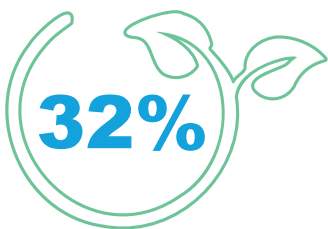


Increase in individual memberships which includes friends and family memberships.

Tikvah annual membership includes our monthly newsletter, periodic friendly phone calls from peers and free or low-cost admission to monthly social programs. Basic membership is open to adults with the lived experience of mental illness at \$20. Friends and family memberships are available at \$50.



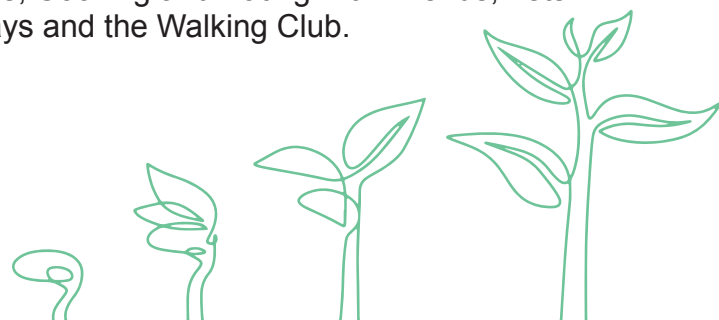
Increase in new participants. Tikvah offers 8-12 social programs each month. Some of these are produced in partnership with other organizations in the community. Our growth in program participation last year was in part due to partnerships with Horizon House, Kaiserman JCC, KenCIDD, KleinLife, NAMI Main Line, NAMI Montgomery County.



Increase in young adult participants Tribe Tikvah is a collaborative ongoing program series to create a community of mental wellness for adults ages 25-45. Peer leaders and staff from Tikvah and our program partner organization Tribe 12 plan and implement programs such as Brunch out with Friends, Goat Yoga, Picnics in the Park with Therapy Dogs, Therapeutic Crafting. A growing number of Tribe Tikvah participants are also taking part in general Tikvah social activities.



Increase in new programs. Tikvah has committed to diversifying our programs to meet the various interests of our current and prospective members. New regular skill building activities introduced in 2023 include Birthday Lunches, Cooking and Eating with Friends, Lets Get Crafty, Volunteer Thursdays and the Walking Club.





Sponsorship Options

\$5000 Builder Provides transportation once a month for city wide Tikvah socialization programs.
