Celebrating 35 Years of Tikvah

Tikvah empowers adults living with a mental illness to feel accomplished, independent, and fulfilled.

We strive to create and support member connections through social and educational programming.

Financial support by individuals and foundations allows Tikvah to continue to provide and grow these community connections.

- **77% of Tikvah participants who answered a recent survey indicated that they feel less isolated being a part of Tikvah.**
- **50% increase in programs hosted or co-sponsored by mission aligned community partners** which allows for expanded program variety and extended outreach in the community.
- **32% increase in volunteers** - in our office, phone squad, peer leaders and content experts at programs, holiday program support and committees. Volunteerism by our members provides a sense of purpose, builds skills, and deepens connections.
- **20% increase in new members** as compared with new members last year. Member referrals and community outreach highlights our success and the need for the work we do.
